### CANDELILLA WAX

(PHC7454)

Refined Candelilla wax is derived from the shrub *Euphorbia Cerifera* native to Northern Mexico and SW United States. Candelilla Wax consists of mainly hydrocarbons, esters and resins. It is insoluble in water but soluble in many organic solvents. It is mostly mixed with other waxes to harden them without raising their melt point.

Candelilla wax is widely used in lipstick, mascara's, as a food additive glazing agent and a binder for chewing gum.
